


## **Problem:**

During installation of TestManager on a Windows 2003 machine, CountDown is unable to create the TestManager Virtual Directory.

## **Install Internet Information Services (IIS)**

1. Start Add/ Remove Programs by clicking the icon shown below:



2. In Windows Component Services, select **Application Server** (it should turn gray as shown below:)



## **Countdown Installation**

During the CountDown installation, if you get a message that TestManager is unable to create the TestManager Virtual Directory:

- 1. Click OK.
- 2. Start IIS Manager.




- 3. Under Web Services Extensions make sure the following is allowed (refer to the picture above for reference):
  - Active Server Pages
  - ASP.NET v4.0.30319
- 4. Expand the Web Sites folder.
- 5. Right-click Default Web Site.
- 6. Click New.


7. Click **Virtual Directory**. This opens the Virtual Directory Creation Wizard.




- 8. Follow the prompts and set the following:
  - Alias to TestManager




• Path to the TestManager directory (the default is shown in the example below).



• Permissions: Read and Run scripts.



When you complete the wizard, the TestManager virtual directory should be created under the Default Web Site folder.
