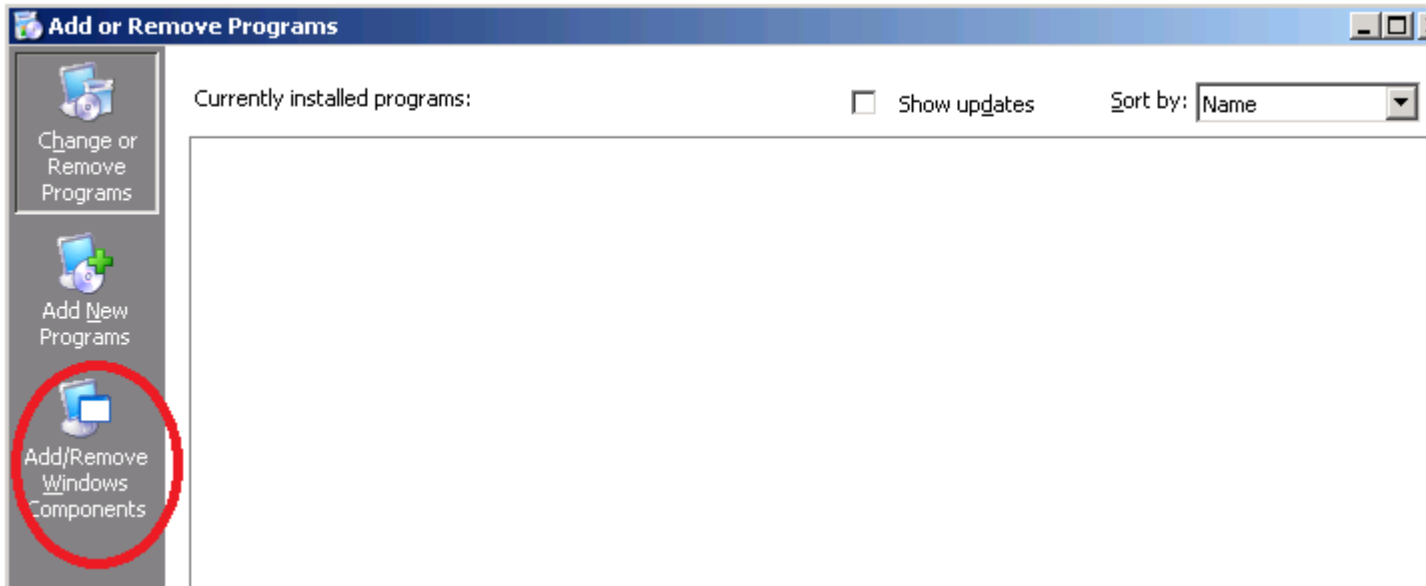
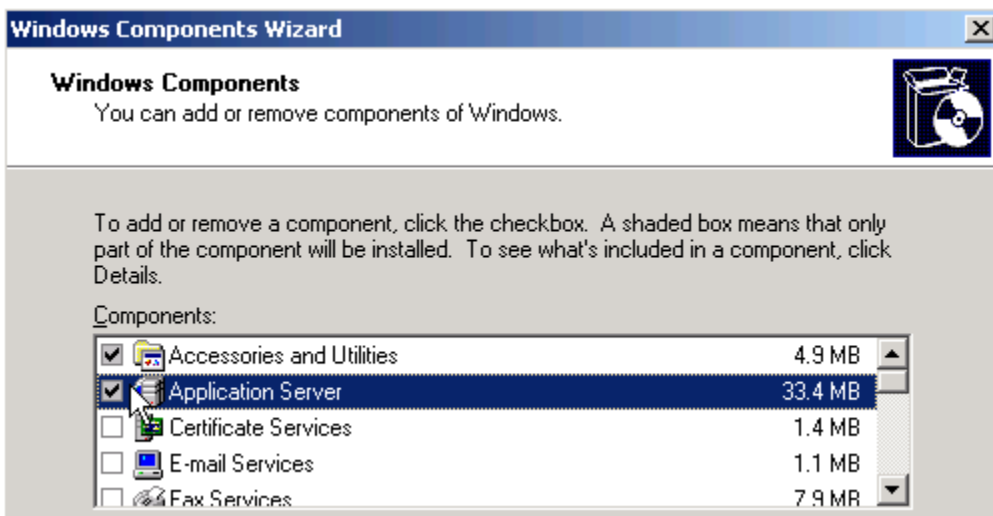


1. Install IIS

- a. Start Add Remove Programs by clicking the picture shown below:



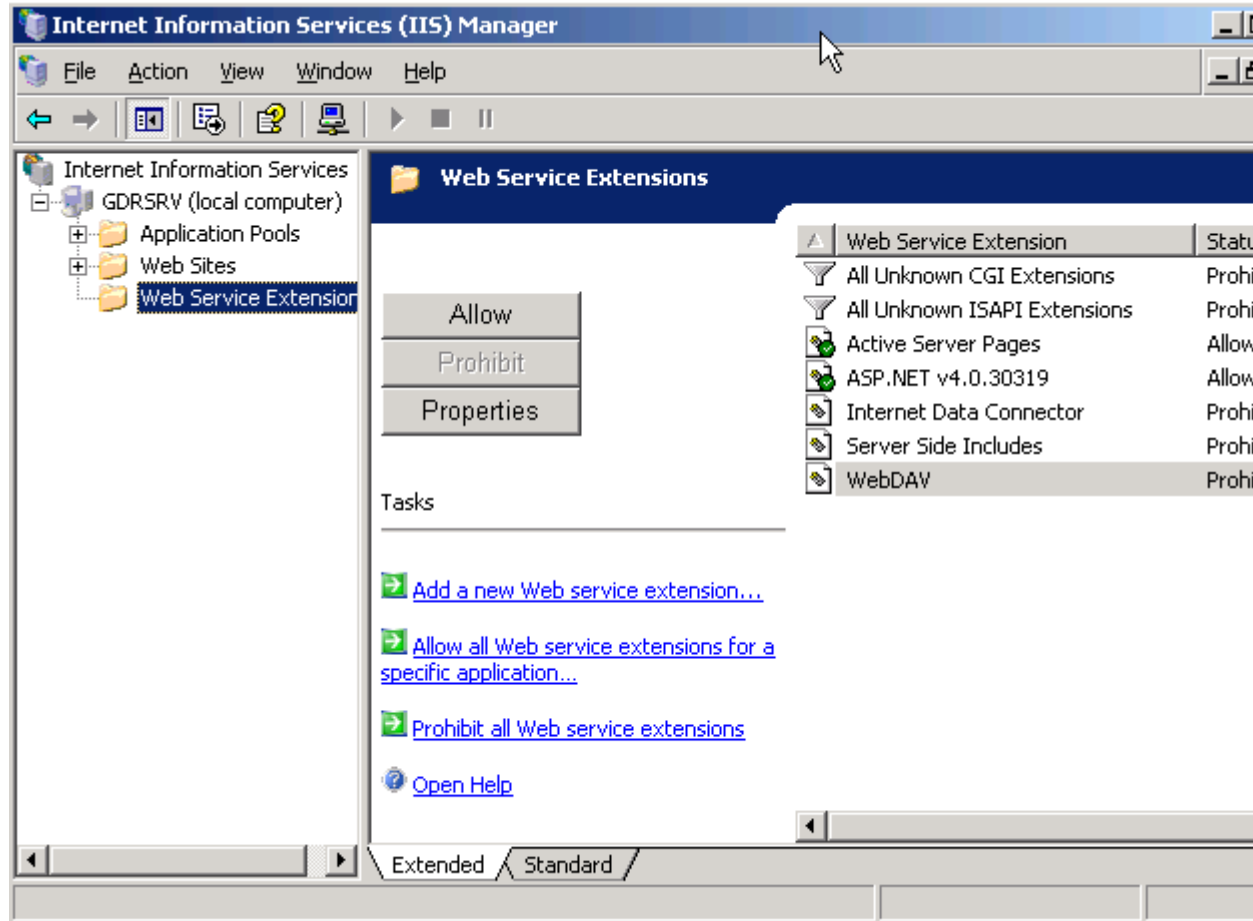
- b. In the Windows Component Services Check Application Server (it should turn gray as shown below:)

3. During the Install you may get a popup about Unable to create TestManager Virtual Directory, click OK, and follow the below steps to fix the problem.

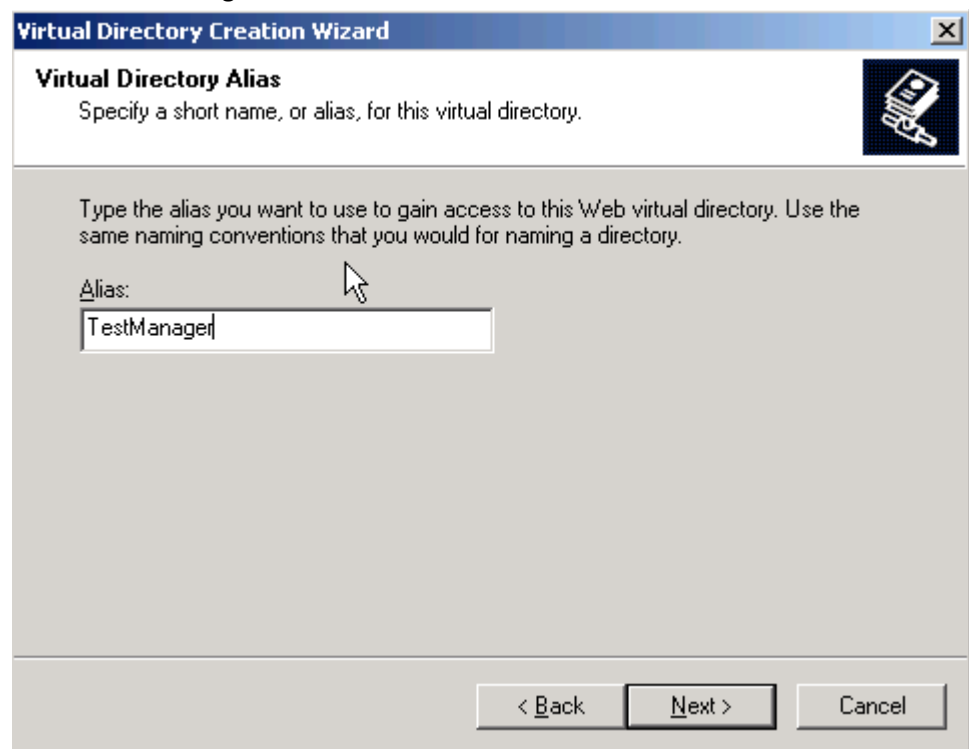
- a. Start Internet Information Services (IIS) Manager



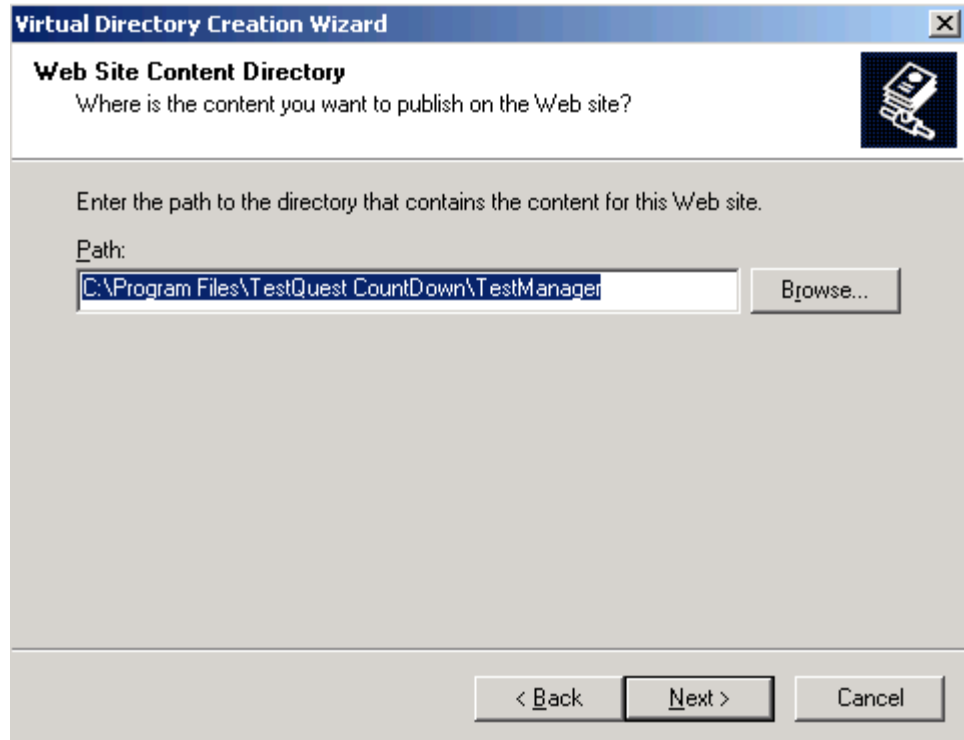
- b. Under Web Services Extensions make sure the following is allowed (refer to above picture for reference)
 - i. Active Server Pages
 - ii. ASP.NET v4.0.30319
- c. Click + next to Web Sites
- d. Right Click Default Web Site
- e. Click New
- f. Click Virtual Directory
- g. This spawns the Virtual Directory Creation Wizard



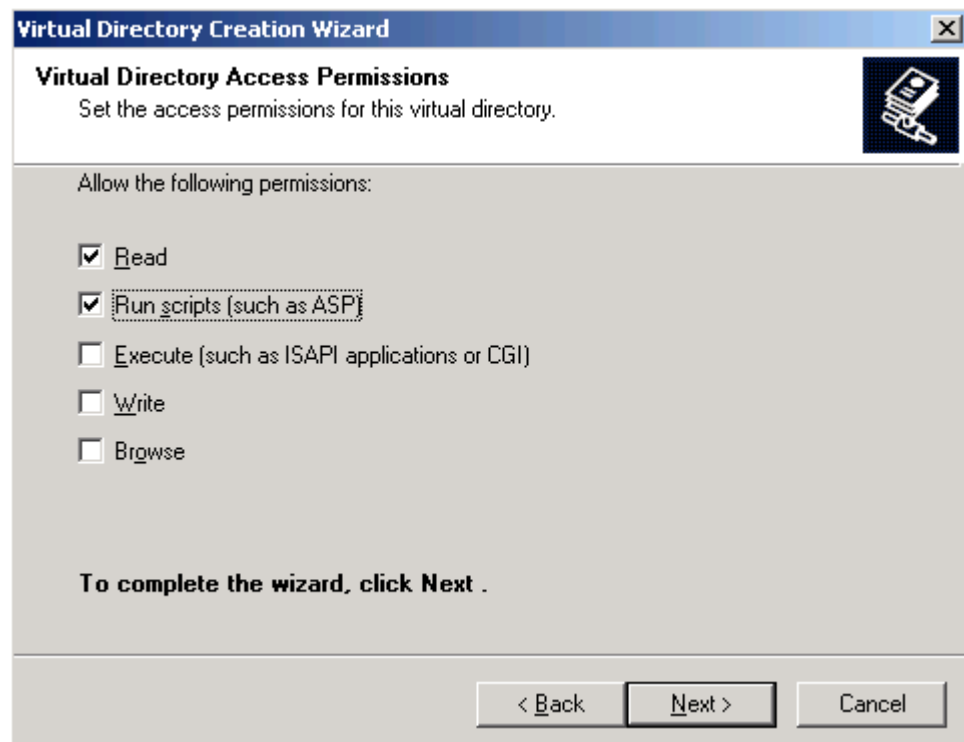
- h. Follow the prompts, and set the following pieces:
 - i. Alias to TestManager



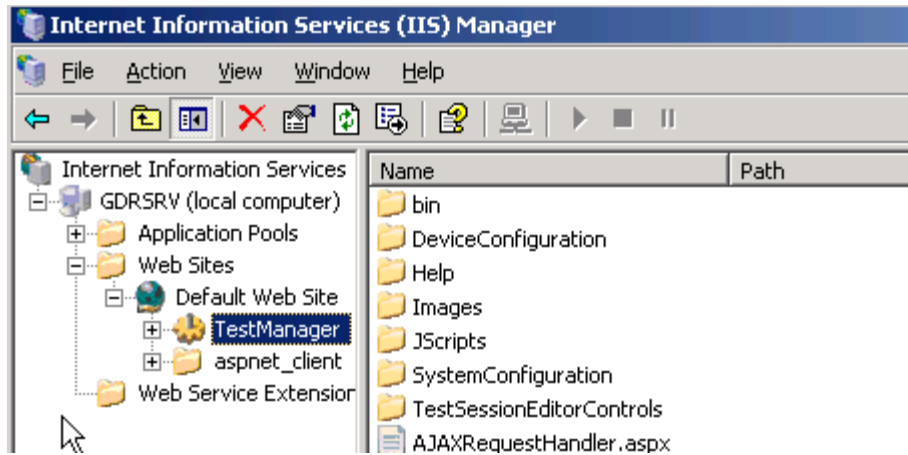
- ii. Path to the TestManager directory (I have put the default in the example).



- iii. Check the Read and Run Scripts section of allow the following permissions.



- iv. Finish the Wizard
- i. Now there should be a TestManager Virtual directory created under the Default Web Site.
